STEWARDSHIP

At the beginning of a new year most of us reflect on the past year, assessing how well we've done. For the believer this introspection has eternal significance. In 2 Cor.5:9-10 Paul writes, "So we make it our goal to please him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad." In 1888, Alfred Nobel, a Swedish chemist who had made a fortune by inventing dynamite, was grieving the death of his brother Ludvig. His grief was turned to anger and frustration when he read his own obituary. The editor had confused the brothers, and the headline read, "The Merchant of Death is dead". Alfred Nobel was described as a warmonger who got rich helping men kill each other. Shaken by this appraisal of his life, he resolved to use his wealth to improve the way the world remembered him. When he died in 1896, he left over nine million dollars to fund awards known as Nobel Prizes for those whose work benefited humanity. He was able to see the assessment of his life at its end while he still had time to change it. If there is little evidence of stewardship in your life, time is of the essence.
