She struggles with hallucinations brought on by her Parkinson's and Lyme's, and they have become worse. She sometimes doesn't want to eat or drink. She has more strength than several weeks ago, but she is bedridden and can't move independently. My brother, John, can visit her for up to two hours a day, and he makes the four-hour round trip drive from Maryland once or twice a week. Please pray for Mom and John's strength, that Mom will eat/drink, and for God's grace on the whole situation. We take it one day at a time." Carol appreciates your prayers for her mom.
