MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT

CHURCH POLITY

Here at AUC we are an Elder and Deacon led, congregational church. Which means that we have 16-21 Elders who guide and direct spiritual and programmatic decisions and 15-18 Deacons who guide and direct the pragmatic issues of finances and facilities, along with the input of our congregation at large. Most of the time the decisions and direction of the Elders and Deacons are influenced by congregation members bringing their interests or concerns to an Elder (pastor) or Deacon, while there are other instances where the congregation makes the decision directly, such as choosing and affirming their leadership annually, voting on constitutional changes, voting in a new senior pastor, and voting on any spending of sums over \$100K. Within this framework, our Elders lead committees that consist of at least two elders and several members at large. These committees cover the areas of Worship, Body Life, Outreach, Christian Education, and Missionaries. The Missionary Committee keeps in contact with every missionary we support to ensure that they are provided for spiritually, emotionally and financially. The Christian Education Committee ensures that the teaching of the church through Bible School, Small Groups, and other speaking opportunities will be in line with our beliefs regarding Scripture. The Outreach Committee seeks to provide ways for our church Body to connect ourselves and the Gospel with the community around us. The Body Life Committee keeps track of membership and leads events that build up and encourage the Body of believers here at AUC. The Worship Committee oversees the elements of any and all of our worship services. If you have any questions about these committees, have suggestions or ideas, or would like to understand how to participate please reach out to an Elder or a Deacon. We want to listen to the leading and movement of God through every member of our Body as we study His word and pray, coming together to fulfill His will for us in this community and the world.
