MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK

RAUL AND CAROLA TORREJON

On December 8, 2021, Carola's mother went to be with the Lord. On February 5, 2022, my younger brother also went to be with the Lord; thank God that my brother received the Lord five days before being with Jesus. God is sovereign. As many already know; Carola and I now find ourselves with an empty nest; our daughter Luisa is at Georgia State University, and Priscila is in Pottersville, NY at the Bible Institute; our son Jonatan and his wife Casey are missionaries serving through Word of Life with us in Bolivia along with our granddaughter. In January, after two years, we started our youth camps for three weeks; about 800 young people attended, and many received Christ as their Savior; I gave workshops challenging young people to be alert to things coming. This year we want to restart evangelism in the streets, support churches in evangelism training, and develop old-fashioned evangelistic campaigns that some churches in Bolivia are asking me to do. We will have our first evangelistic campaign on March 24 to 27 in Sucre and our second on April 14 to 17 in the town of Santa Cruz. Please pray for the provision of a car to mobilize us; unfortunately, in Bolivia, second-hand cars range from \$6,000 to \$7,000. Please pray that the Lord strengthens our daughters; it is not easy for them as international students; thank you, dear church, for your support.
