(Psalm 96:3) Worship is the goal and the fuel of missions: Missions exists because worship doesn't. Missions is our way of saying: the joy of knowing Christ is not a private, or tribal, or national or ethnic privilege. It is for all. We have tasted the joy of worshiping Jesus, and we want all the families of the earth included. Seeking the worship of the nations is fueled by the joy of our own worship. You can't commend what you don't cherish.

People must be told about Jesus, because there is no salvation, and no worship where the gospel of Christ is not heard and believed. God is committed to gathering worshipers from all the peoples of the world, not just all the countries of the world. This is what "all nations" means in the Great Commission. Nations like Ojibwe, and Fulani, and Kachin, not like the United States, and Japan, and Argentina. The gospel has already reached all the countries, but there are over seven thousand unreached peoples. Let's pray that our joyful worship of Jesus leads us to increasingly declare his glory among the nations.
