TOBY AND SARA SHANNON

We can see God's hand in advancing the vision He has given us for providing biblical counseling to missionaries and relief workers! We had a final interview with a larger organization that also had the dream. I (Sara) am approved to come on board to coordinate this worldwide effort! We have eight other counselors and requests from missionaries from other countries, including Lebanon and some forced to leave China. I have been teaching biblical Conflict Resolution and crisis counseling via Zoom in Spanish with church leaders in many countries. Tabitha is almost finished in her 2nd year of pediatric residency. She and her husband, Ajoy, have purchased their own home. Daughter Heidi is well into her first year of nursing in a transplant hospital in Cleveland. Son Luke and fiancée Whitney have postponed their wedding until June of 2022. Luke is enjoying the challenges of being a "1st Engineer" in the merchant marines. Daughter Nellie is living and working in Maine. As Peru opens back up, we are beginning to plan Mission Work Teams to construct the new Training Center for Quechua people with disabilities. For PHASE 1 of the construction, we will need builders, masons, welders, and general handypersons. Due to the climate in central Peru, this can be any time of the year.
