It is far more than our weekly times of gathered worship or our personal times of Bible study, devotion, and prayer, though these are important. In fact, worship is not defined by any physical location or activity we may associate with it (John 4:20-24). The transformative worship that Christ seeks is primarily in our hearts, minds, and desires (Rom. 12:1-2). It is first a state of being out of which our actions and words flow (Luke 6:45). When we recognize Christ as the King of our hearts, we can surrender our ambitions, our agendas, and our need for earthly power and prestige. In meekness, with a hunger and thirst for his righteousness and a peace that cannot be shaken, we can endure the trials of life and seek to play our individual and collective parts in demonstrating the mercy, justice, and reconciliation that Christ calls us to as ambassadors of his eternal Kingdom (Matt. 5:3-12, 2 Cor. 5:17-20). This is worship—a life so overwhelmed with the glorious reality of God and his story of redemption that it cannot help but respond in love toward humanity whom he created, loves, and desires to know him (1 Tim. 2:4).
