"Greetings from Nicaragua. We are greatly saddened because we have not been able to travel to the US as planned this summer to visit you and many others personally. Flights in and out of Nicaragua were canceled and have not reopened. We managed to finish the school year at the International school at the end of May through emergency distance learning processes. Our focus now, over the summer, is to come up with a comprehensive plan to try and return to some level of physical presence classes in the fall with more significant training and support for teachers and students. Our National schedule schools also continue on distance learning processes and are making adjustments as time permits. None of these situations are ideal and not everyone will be satisfied with the decisions. Pray for our leaders, staff, parents, and students as we work to demonstrate Christian love and community in a context that is currently pushing for physical distancing and inadvertently creating other more destructive distancing and heartache. Pray for the people of Nicaragua as there is little official information about how things are going in-country, but we know it is present and taking a toll. The health system is not sufficient, and the already battered economy has been deeply affected.
