Nathan will be traveling to Guatemala in early August to connect with a group of potential schools for participation in Missionary Ventures' school strengthening process. Cory was traveling to Guatemala in June to visit her family for the first time in three years. Bryan finished his first year at Wheaton, visited for two weeks in May, and will spend the rest of the summer working in Atlanta.
