MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK

GEORGE DEEMIE

George is a Liberian national serving as the National Director/Founder of the Liberia Goodwill Evangelical Mission (Gem). The Team reaches the rural community through the Jesus film, healthcare outreach, leadership, and discipleship development. Our health team provides reproductive health assistance to rural dwellers, accounting for 26 live birth deliveries in recent months. They also provide health and sanitation education and awareness services to 47 catchments and rural communities in target areas. These communities also benefit from immunization services. George continues coordinating team activities from the USA, with frequent Zoom meetings and discipleship training. Pray for God's protection for George's wife and children in Liberia. Praise God for our Team's protection as they work in rugged terrain. We used AUC's gift to install 22 window bars and four iron doors and lay the cement floor in the conference room. Praise God for continued open doors and opportunities to share the Gospel. We face many financial challenges and would appreciate your prayers for God's provision. Pray for laborers for the harvest. Pray for God to intervene so George can travel to Liberia, wisdom for the US Board, and prayer against Islamic and all demonic activity again Liberia and the preaching of the Gospel. Pray for God's safety and protection during this heavy rainy season.
