### **VOTER REGISTRATION**

Paul writes in Romans 13:1 "Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God." God explicitly expresses an obligation to our government that is derived from His authority. As Americans, we are allowed the unique opportunity to influence our laws. For Christians, this means we must bring our biblical worldview to the public square. If you are 18 years of age and older and are not a registered voter, there will be a Voter Registration table in the Gym during Connection Time where you can pick up/fill out an application. This will be available the following Sundays: September 10, 17, and 24, and October 1, 8, and 15. The deadline for registering is October 23 for voting in the November election.
