"Thanks for all your prayers. In July, we started to record the Old Testament for the Cuzco Quechua. Pastor Mariano and Pastor Roberto are recording Monday to Friday. Praise God, their health is good. Pray for these pastors and their families. We need one more voice, but because of the COVID, Cuzco is closed. Pray for Pastor Isaias Cuchillo to join us when national flights open. We think we will need 2 or 3 more months of recording. Pray for the \$18,000 to cover all the costs. It is a big challenge, but because of this pandemic, we realized that people are hungry and need to hear the Gospel in their language. Our next recording will be for the Ayacucho Quechua language. We have received a request from the Bible Society in Spain to record the NT. Pray for God to open doors for flights, provision, and safety for our team. We know if this is what God wants, He will provide. Family: Antonia is growing fast, and she is a gift from the Lord to us. Thank you for praying for Monica when her grand mom went home to be with the Lord. Pray for Monica's health. She has problems with her right hand, and her right leg. She can only take small steps. Because of COVID, she can't go to therapy. We aren't sure if this is Parkinson's related. Pray for a good neurologist to help and get her needed therapy. Thank you for your support."
