## **MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK**

#### **JAIME & MONICA ALMEIDA**

"We rented a house near ILMA. This is the link for our video https://vimeo.com/356733128. The translators return November 10 to record the 4 languages simultaneously. For this, we have to set up the rooms for 16 people; beds, accessories and painting; build another studio; two more laptops plus new mixers and accessories for the studio, and pay double the rent. Pray for God to provide \$5000 for the rooms; \$7600 to build the recording studio, and \$28,000 to get new studio equipment including instruments. In Peru we have 10 languages that have the printed Bible and the recorded New Testament. People visit the city and ask if we have more materials. With our new place and equipment, we can record the OT. They will be able to hear the Bible in their own language. ILMAV is committed to provide the Bible in Peru and Latin America. We have more projects to start in Paraguay, Colombia, Brazil and Bolivia. God is opening doors. Your prayers and support are needed! Baby Antonia is growing fast. We are thankful for all the support from Aldan Union when Antonia was in the clinic. Now she is walking and wants to touch everything. Monica will start another therapy to control the movement in her right hand. Pray for her health, strength as a mom, and helping in the ministry. Thank you! We value your partnership and friendship to proclaim His Name to all nations, tribes and different tongues."
