#### **RUTH DOUGHERTY**

Events in Afghanistan are weighty on my heart. It's so hard getting calls, texts, etc., from former local colleagues and friends wanting our help to leave. We feel so helpless. Since we know God is their only hope, offering to pray seems so lame to them since they pray to a callous, judgmental God who doesn't care. At our Helping Hands center, we meet refugee friends grieving for their families and friends left in Afghanistan, fearful and desperate, and starving under Taliban rule. Yet, God is growing His church in Afghanistan. It is the second-fastest-growing church in the world after Iran, while believers are being persecuted and killed. One Afghan pastor requested, "Pray for the living and dying grace for believers." Thankfully all of my former expatriate colleagues made it safely out. Pray for them as they are displaced and hurt so much for our loyal local colleagues left behind. Pray for a weekly jigsaw puzzle outreach to Dari-speaking Afghan women, showing a Magdalena film clip in Dari, along with a discussion and reading-related verses. A prayer time for their family and friends will follow, plus a time to do puzzles and build relationships with these women. Ask God to send just the right women since COVID restrictions still significantly limit the number of attendees. I thank God for your faithful prayers and generous gifts!
