Angel Tree has been struggling to respond to the pandemic and various restrictions in place around the country. Some churches have dropped out of the program due to the pandemic. We at AUC were committed to serve 70 children of prisoners with a gift and a message of love and hope in Jesus Christ. We decided that we needed to honor that commitment and continue this outreach, so will be participating in the Angel Tree Outreach Ministry virtually this year, We chose the virtual option over the traditional method of outreach due to safety concerns for our congregation and participating families and the likely reluctance of people letting strangers into their homes and limited availability to share with the families involved. Families reached will get a gift card for the kids, a "Book of Hope" with a strong Gospel message, and an opportunity to receive a free Bible. Lord willing we are planning to invite all the families involved to gather at the church after Christmas for a time to share God's love as restrictions permit, as well as reaching out to the prisoners letting them know that we have shared a gift of love to their kids in Christ's name.
