This past year was encouraging as I was able to start teaching English again. Without wifi access for most Senegalese, doing classes or Bible clubs was not possible. It was such a pleasure to teach my two classes and see their hard work pay off by the end of the year. Sadly, we could not resume Kids Clubs in the villages in 2021, but some villages continued to have clubs on their own, and we are grateful for that. As 2022 approaches, I hope to be teaching English again, and Awa is in the process of setting up the schedule for Kids clubs in the villages. The school is currently not accredited. If we do get accredited, then there will be government regulations. There are two tracks of learning, sewing and cooking/ hospitality. They also learn mathematics, French, and English. I would also need to get accredited to teach English. Would you please pray for God's will about this? The COVID vaccination program is well underway in Senegal. Still, only 3.5% of the population is fully vaccinated, and it will take a long time to reach people in villages and remote areas. Would you please pray that the vaccination program will continue and we won't have any interruptions in school or village ministry in the coming year? We praise God for His protection, as some of our team members and Senegalese friends were ill with COVID but are doing well now.
