Thanks to all of you who have been praying for us and helping to support us for these past 59 years since Aldan sent us to work with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Peru. Even though retired, Barb and I continue to promote the use of the translated Scriptures among the Quechua-speaking people of Ayacucho, Peru.

Some of our disciples produce radio programs in Quechua to reach their people for Christ and train others to do the same. The most impressive thing is hearing the Bible promoters' testimonies and how God is working, saving, and healing many needy people. It is something like out of the book of Acts. When the people see Jesus speaking to them in Quechua, they talk back to him, ask him to do or say something. They will do what he says, especially at the end of the video with the invitation, when Jesus tells them that he loves them and wants to come into their lives and forgive them their sins. Others are trained and equipped with DVD video players to show the videos of Luke and Genesis and are evangelizing and teaching the Scriptures and training others to do so. They have also put the whole New Testament on small audio players and promoted the Word. We try to look for funding for all their work, equipment and we also translate their reports.
