We want to thank God for this blessed partnership with Aldan Union Church, your missionary vision, and your love for missionaries and lost people. We want to thank God and you for 39 years as one of AUC's missionaries. I am the camp director, reaching kids and teens for Jesus. My wife and children are entirely involved and helping in the ministry. We have seen over 3,500 campers accept Jesus as their Savior. I also work as the Executive Director for VFC Mission in Brazil. Years ago, we started a ministry called Kid's Place, where we embrace and receive 120 kids and teens yearly from a slum called Coque. They also get two meals per day, extra education, and Bible teachings. With Pastor Josué, we started a church at a fishing village called Abreu do Una. The church is growing and has over 150 members attending. Pastor Gilson and his family work as missionaries in the Amazon jungle area, reaching the riverside people for Jesus. God is faithful to us. I hope some of you will come to Brazil to help us and see what God has done here. Please keep these ministries, missionaries, and my family in your prayers. We are in the process of selecting and training the staff for the January camps. Pray for the Kid's Place ministry and Áurea Delgado, the new director.
