"We give thanks to all who have prayed for us and helped to support us for these past 52 years since you all sent us to work with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Peru. Even though retired, Barb and I continue to promote the translated Scriptures among the Quechua speaking people of Ayacucho, Peru. Some of our disciples are producing radio programs in Quechua to reach their people and training others to do the same. Others are trained as Bible promoters and are equipped with digital photo frame units to show Luke and Genesis's videos. The most impressive thing is to hear the Bible promoters' testimonies and how God is working, saving, and healing many needy people. They also have many opportunities to show these videos in public schools in the required religion classes. Scores of children are receiving Christ, and the teachers are asking for Bibles for themselves. They now have daily Bible readings in all these schools, and our Bible promoters have given out over 200 Bibles to students and teachers. Pray the Lord will provide the funds for workers, audio-video equipment, and training. Pray for health and strength to continue this work."
